# **RULES OF SHOW**

- All exhibits are to be grown or produced by the exhibitor and to be owned by them.
- Section 3 – **Limit of 2 entries per person per Class.**
- Entry fee: Adults—£1 for 1st entry, 50p thereafter.
- Child 20p per entry. Sambrook House Residents 20p per entry
- Entry form and fee to be in for closing date—5th Sept 2024 20:00
- The hall will be open for exhibits to be received: 9.00-12.00pm Saturday 7th Sept 2024
- No exhibits are to be fixed to the walls of the hall.
- Exhibitors are not to move or adjust other than their own without specific agreement of the Stewards.
- Prize Cards will be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in each adult class. There will be a small cash reward for each child's class & Prize for Exhibitor with most pts in show (Child classes only)
- The exhibitors must supply all plates, dishes and other receptacles. At all times before, during and after the show, such articles and exhibits will be left at the exhibitors' own risk and it is a condition of the entry that the officers & committee shall be under no liability for the loss, theft or damage thereto.
- The judges may at their own discretion and without giving reason, disqualify any entry. In all respects the decision of the judges shall be final, and the judges will not be required to give reason for such decisions.
- The judges shall, if they consider there are insufficient entries or if no entry of sufficient merit, withhold prizes.
- Children may compete in Adult Classes.
- Cups are to be held for 1 Year or until the next show.
  - Mabel Johnson Award – for exhibitor with most points in Whole Show
  - The Sambrook Produce Show Cup—for exhibitor with most points in Photography Section.
  - The Advertiser Cup—for exhibitor with highest points in cookery section
  - The Romeo Rose Bowl—for exhibitor with highest points in Hobbies/Handicrafts (classes 401-407, 410-414).
  - The Three Horseshoes Trophy—for exhibitor with highest points in Section 1
  - The Mabel Johnson Children's Cup—Child with most points in Show
